**International Summer School for students of architecture 10<sup>th</sup> –19<sup>th</sup> of August 2006**  
**– residents given an active role in participation**

The summer school for students and young professionals of architecture in Jyväskylä is hosted this year in Lutakko 10<sup>th</sup>–19<sup>th</sup> of August. The event is organized in co-operation with Jyväskylä Urban Planning Department, Centre for Urban and Regional Studies (YTK) in Helsinki University of Technology and the International Federation for Housing and Planning (IFHP).

The topic of the summer school 2006 in Jyväskylä is “Urban scales: adapting architecture”.

The summer school will be participated by 20 students from different countries around the world. The students will examine in groups the structure of the Lutakko harbour area and search for new solutions for the future development of the site. The most part of the work will take place in the facilities of the rock club Tanssisali Lutakko.

The official opening event will be organized on the 11th of August at 3.00 pm in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor working studio of Tanssisali Lutakko. This will be followed by a guided walk through the area together with the students and the residents of Lutakko. On the 14<sup>th</sup> of August a halfway critique is held in the working studio starting at 2.30 pm. The final critique takes place at the Urban Planning Department on the 18<sup>th</sup> of August at 9.00 am.

The summer school is guided by professor, architect Ksenija Hiel from the University of Novi Sad in Serbia and architect Anne Sandelin from the City of Jyväskylä Urban Planning Department. Also other professionals from the Urban Planning Department will participate in the tutoring.

All residents and guests are welcome to the events. Residents are also invited to visit the students' working studio and observe the on-going planning. Participants of the summer school are present at the studio all day. Neste Oil Rally Finland sets some limitations to accessing the area, so during the rally visits should be agreed in advance.
